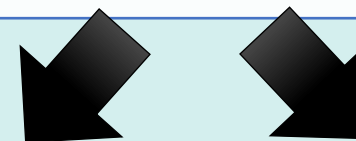


# TOO MUCH NOISE ABOUT CARBON FARMING

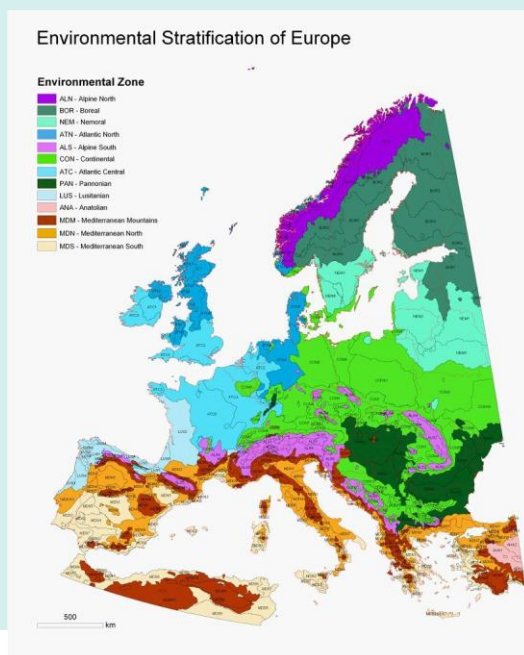


Estimate carbon

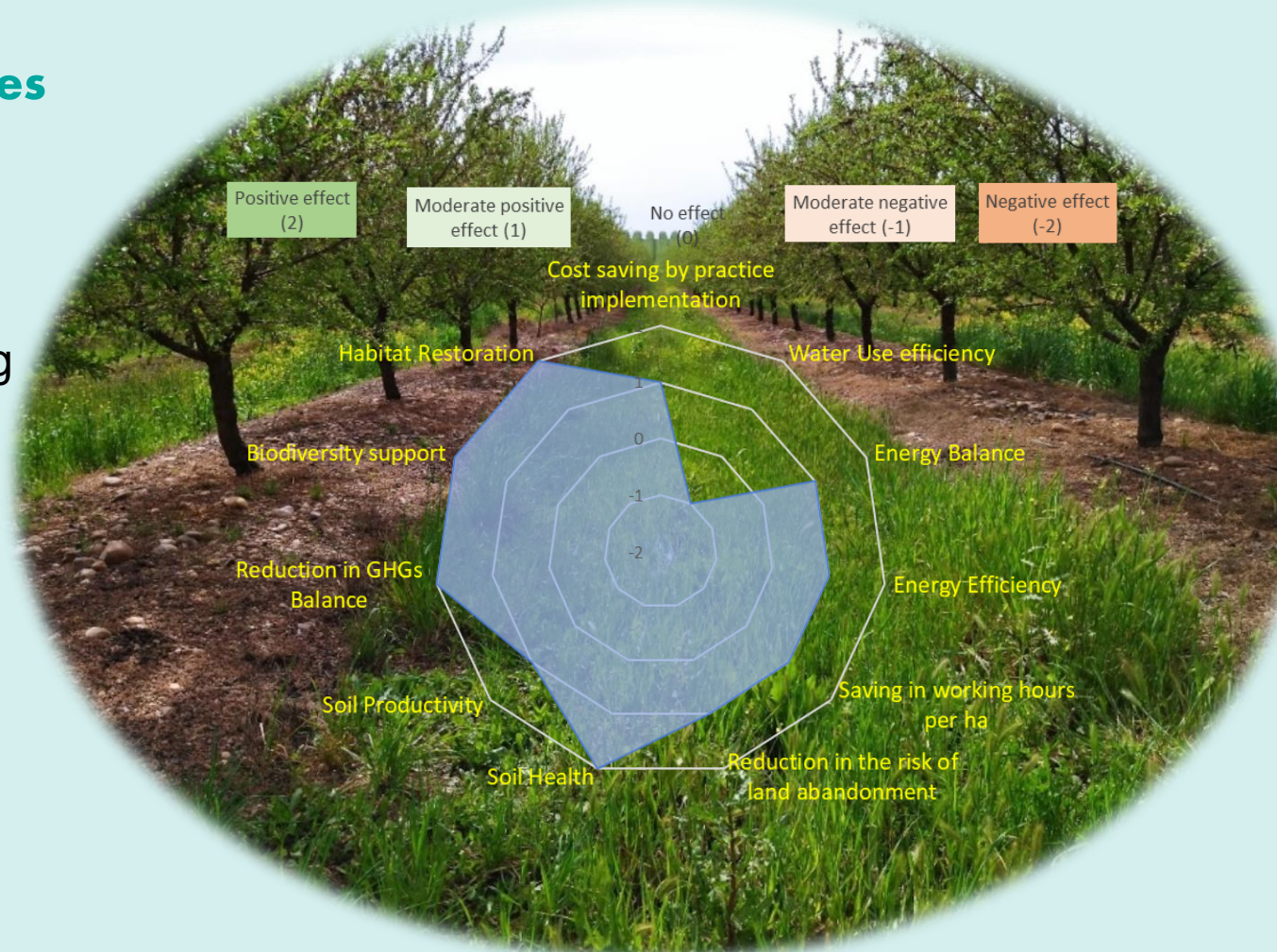
